

Just got back from one of the Texas Lion Trainer Development Workshop sponsored by our MD2-COG's (IDK about the other 20 participants, but I thought it was GR8! Great job S5 DG Andy Rodriquez!) and immediately figured out I had not sent out the TLERC monthly newsletter.

For years we have played the "pneumonic" game, shortening everything until, nobody knows what anything means. Well, now our kids and grandkids have created a whole new language that they use to communicate on messages and "tweets". LOL (laughing out loud), TTYL (talk to you later), LROF (rolling on floor laughing) and one you parents better learn, AITR (adult in the room) are all part of the new vocabulary. Not to be outdone, the senior citizens have a few of their own like LOL (living on Lipitor), ATD (at the Doctor), and ROFL-CGU (rolling on floor laughing-can't get up). Whatever the reason I want to share some great new things we are doing to communicate better.

TLERC has a new power point presentation, titled "Out of the Darkness" complete with audio. The new presentation should be in the hands of your TLERC District Directors in a couple of weeks. Contact them to bring a great and informative program to your Club, Zone or District.

It is also available to any Club on a thumb drive, just for the asking. It is just under 20 minutes to show. This should allow many more Lions see the great work that is going on right here in Texas to help those less fortunate get "Out of the Darkness". 
