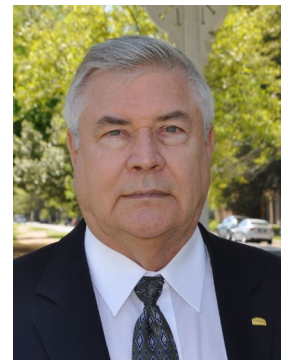

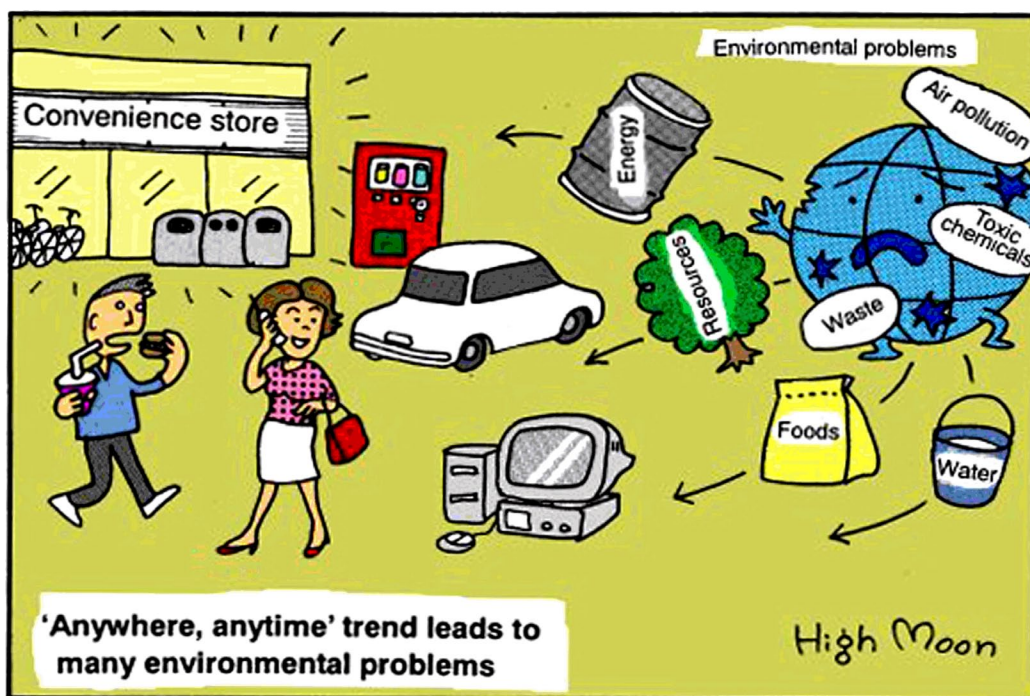
This brings back the story of Helen Keller. One person touched her and she touched millions including we “Lions”. That one new Lion – Who Knows!!
