Wow what a month! What an outpouring of Love... And in my humble opinion unequalled in history. The sad part is that we need to continue this outpouring for a long, long time. So, after Jane and I returned from our trip to South America, we celebrated my mother's 100th birthday! Then sat like everyone else watching it rain day after day. Once it stopped raining we volunteered at the local shelter, helped with placement of a disabled senior, drove around to all the first responders in our area and offered to provide meals, helped at Crisis Assistance Center sorting clothes, worked with Conroe Noon and helped prepare and serve 200 meals, then Jane and I parted ways she worked the night shift as an RN at the shelter, while I headed up a team of Lions and we stripped Sheetrock and insulation out of flooded homes.

If you missed PSC it focused on disaster relief. What LCIF is doing, what clubs around the world are doing, and what we are doing. It was a well-attended and informative meeting.

On Monday, the 11th LCIF Chairman Bob Corlew arrived with a film crew and we spent 3 days escorting them to various areas so they could see firsthand the devastation Harvey brought to Texas. The film crew is developing a video to raise awareness and help raise monies for Harvey relief. While traveling with Chairman Corlew and the film team, I got to see firsthand myself a small portion of the damage Harvey brought. Words cannot express the sorrow I feel, and emotions that I witnessed, or the damage we viewed.

I know we all have stories of what happened, damage caused, and the witnessing of the acts of service Lions preformed. I am so proud of our district and the efforts we are putting out. If you have a special Lion you want to recognize, you can make Melvin Jones donations to LCIF and earmark the funds to District 2-S2 for Harvey relief. Well, Harvey certainly managed to upstage most everything else that was planned for Labor Day! Kingwood, where I live was particularly hard hit as we lost a huge number of homes in areas that had never flooded before and so carried no insurance. The water rose so rapidly that we were evacuated by boat with just a packet of belongings. We also lost both cars and of course numerous keepsakes etc.

Kingwood also lost our Town Center and a lot of other businesses – 160 in total! This has a major effect on the local community since so many jobs were lost as a result and it will be months before they are back. We lost one of our high schools which will be out of action for a full year so we are bussing nearly 3,000 students every day to another high school an hour away!

Lions reacted in typical fashion after a disaster and we had a \$100,000 grant within days. We were also honored by a visit from the Chairman of LCIF, Immediate Past International President Bob Corlew. He spent 3 days in the area and was able to see first-hand the devastation and understand the needs which will be significant and long-lasting. Thanks to the initial grant and our local knowledge of our communities many of the lesser known organizations have already been able to get immediate help.

Please remember to support LCIF at the club level as that is what make the rapid response possible. Make sure you recognize a Melvin Jones Fellow every year as a first step.


When Lions Roar ...

Our District Governor Betty Ezell may be soft-spoken. She may even be sweeter than your own mother. She's typically the first one we think about asking when we need a few words to lift us up in prayer. But, when you hear that Lion ROAR, you are filled with a "Can-Do" spirit that lifts you and empowers you to achieve more than you ever thought possible. The experience of our recent hurricane nightmare really showed us the grit that our District Governor is made of.

As the storm was ravaging the lower Texas Gulf Coast, the Texas Lions requested and were granted a \$100,000 emergency disaster relief grant from the Lions Clubs International Foundation. Realizing this storm would move north and adversely impact the majority of the Texas Gulf Coast, it would be resources well spent. Among the DG's in the four most severely affected areas, our Governor Betty was chosen by the Council of Governors to lead the team of Governors and manage the relief efforts. She quickly enlisted the talents of PDG Noah Speer to manage the resource allocation and coordinate supplies readiness efforts. He worked throughout the storm and relief efforts like a well-seasoned quartermaster.

At the height of the storm, Governor Betty called around to the Zone and Region Chairs to see if they could help identify Lions in need. She reached out herself to our Club Presidents in the areas most severely impacted and found many communities desperately in need of basic resources. Our Governor directed relief supplies where they were needed most. Governor Betty pulled together Lions, PDGs and Committee Chairs to form a disaster response team and work together to provide assistance in our communities. When our Governor was asked to coordinate a humanitarian visit from the Chairman of Lions Clubs International Foundation, she asked a team of Lion leaders to work together and guide Immediate Past International President Bob Corlew around our District to see first-hand the impact of raging flood waters. IPIP Bob visited with volunteers at supplies distribution centers and area refugee shelters. He comforted homeowners who experienced severe damage to their property and even travelled to remote areas to see the destruction of homes only accessible by boat. At every stop, Governor Betty was there, inspiring us with her compassion, spirit of service and heart of a true Lion. Governor Betty makes me very proud to say "I'm a Lion and I'm PROUD!" Thank you, Governor Betty for leading us through this challenging time with passion, charm, grace and heart.







THE PROBLEM

Measles is one of the most contagious yet easily prevented diseases in the world. It is still very much a deadly threat to people in areas that lack access to vaccinations. In fact, measles is a leading cause of vaccine-preventable deaths among children. The World Health Organization (WHO) estimates 122,000 deaths a year still occur due to measles.

For less than US\$1, a child can be immunized against measles for life, making the vaccine potentially the most cost-effective health intervention available. Ending measles can be a reality, but your help is needed. Lions have engaged in a long-term partnership with the GAVI Alliance, committing US\$30 million towards the fight against measles by our 100th anniversary in 2017.

THERE IS HOPE

In 2000, before the Measles Initiative was formed, more than 562,000 children died each year due to measles complications. Fortunately, between 2000 and 2012 increased access to vaccinations reduced measles deaths by 78 percent worldwide. In 2012, about 84 percent of children worldwide received a vaccination by their second birthday. But 335 children still die each day from measles.

Today, Lions, LCIF and our partners are hard at work, reaching those children who have not yet been vaccinated. Since becoming involved in the fight against measles in 2010, Lions and our partners have helped to vaccinate more than 200 million children. Through our newest partnership with the GAVI Alliance, millions more children will receive the vaccination.

A NEW CHALLENGE

Through the partnership with the GAVI Alliance, Lions will continue to provide financial support to deliver needed vaccinations, social mobilization and advocacy efforts in the fight against measles and rubella. When you donate to Lions Measles Initiative, your donation will be matched 1 to 1 by the GAVI Matching Fund, which is financially supported by the United Kingdom's Department for International Development (DFID) and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. This matching program doubles the impact of your gift, bringing the total to US\$60 million. 

Lions District 2-S2 Humanitarian Relief Fund Matching Funds Request Form

HRF provides funds for local disaster relief and to aid Lions Clubs in humanitarian efforts that are beyond the resources of the individual club. HRF will match funds (up to \$1,250) raised by clubs to aid their projects.
