## **Thought's from the Second Vice District Governor:**

The Bob Dowden dinner has come and gone again. If you weren't there, you missed a great night. It was a fun time and all involved with helping to put it on are to be congratulated. On the drive home that night, I kept reflecting on a couple of related things. The first was Trish Wilson's talk. It was great seeing her and as always, she gave a great talk. In case you missed it, it began with retelling part of the movie Dead Poet's Society, where Robin William's character first tells his students "Carpe Diem!" Seize the day! Seizing the day, we don't seem to do that enough in our personal lives, our professional lives or our lives as Lions or maybe it is just me that doesn't seize the day.

The other thing was the autographed baseball sitting in the passenger seat that I bought at the live auction. The baseball was autographed by José Lima. Anyone even remotely interested in baseball and living in Houston during the late 90's should remember José Lima. He was a pitcher whose best years were with the Houston Astros, specifically in the Astrodome. José was known for his animated gestures on the pitching mound and referring to his own pitching outings as "Lima Time". The same acts that might rub opposing players the wrong way endeared him to the Astros fans. In 1999, José won 21 games and was named to the All Star Team. The next year, the Astros and Lima moved from the pitcher-friendly Astrodome to the hitter-friendly Enron Field. The same fly-ball that would be easily caught in the Astrodome sailed high over the fence at Enron Field. He wasn't the same pitcher and was soon traded to the Detroit Tigers and played for a few other teams over the next few seasons. He was never the same pitcher, but he always had the same attitude. It was still "Lima Time baby" and he was as animated as ever during his final few years in the league. José Lima passed away in 2010, just 4 years after his last major league game, from a massive heart attack.

On the ride home, I couldn't help but think about Trish's talk and José Lima's career. How even when José didn't have the pitching success he had before, he always seemed to seize the day with his attitude. So let's take a lesson from José Lima and proclaim "It's Lion Time baby!" and proceed to seize the day.

The theme for the Bowl-a-thon will be a "Return to the 50's". Participants will be encouraged to dress for the era. While the Lions of District 2-S4 have held successful Bowl-A-Thons for years, this will be 2-S2's very first such event.



Lions Eye Bank of Texas Proceeds from the Bowl-a-thon benefit the Lions Eye Bank of Texas, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, located in the Texas Medical Center. The Lions Eye Bank of Texas provides services to the entire Texas Gulf Coast and parts of East Texas.

It exists to promote the work of the Lions Eye Bank of Texas at Baylor College of Medicine. In particular, provide community education and outreach programs about the importance of cornea donation, prevention for the causes of preventable corneal blindness along with providing corneas at no charge to patients in need of a transplant.

In 2011, the Lions Eye Bank of Texas at Baylor College of Medicine provided over 1,400 donor corneas for transplantation.

### *Teams*

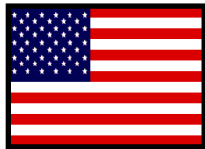
