Greetings from Belize!

For those of you who do not know Lion Jane and I try to go on 2 medical mission trips a year. We usually travel to Corozal City, Belize and assist doctors that are preforming surgeries on the indigent. Jane travels as the RN and I go as the team coordinator. While we are just starting this weeks trip, we are changing the lives of 9 people today, and hope to preform 40+ surgeries this week.

The past month has been busy. We had the Centennial celebration in Dallas, club meetings in various areas, and I have been very busy with the Harvey Task force, while Lion Jane has been busy trying to get her brother moved down from Connecticut.

We have done wonders around the District, and DG Betty deserves a huge thank you for all she has done in leading the way to serving others. A number of clubs have submitted projects that we have been able to fund through grants that we have received. We have built wheel-chair ramps, approved flooring in a flooded house, wheelchairs for disabled, provided food for evacuees and first responders, and the list goes on and on. DG Betty is currently working on getting funding approved for a shelter that needs repair and is still hosting evacuees.

The road to recovery is a long one, and It is estimated that it will take 11 years for this area to recover from Harvey. That means that the road ahead for our district is paved with opportunities. I am seeking those forward thinkers who wish to serve during the next Cabinet. If you are interested in serving in a particular position, I would appreciate it if you would let me know. I will be reaching out to members over the next few months to try and fill all the positions.

Thank you to each of you who has contributed in any way to Hurricane Harvey Relief. No matter how small you may think your contribution is it all adds up to the biggest relief effort our District has handled in many years. And please keep it up as we will be dealing with the aftermath for many more months and perhaps years to come. The District, Multiple District and LCIF will all help but it is your feet on the ground that will make it successful. Please make sure that your club has good communications with the District as we will be putting out a lot of information via email and may need a fast response to help us manage the effort.

During the Centennial celebration in Dallas I was able to sit in on the meeting of the Task Force set up by the Multiple District. It includes the governors of the 4 districts affected and also our PDG Noah Speer as the administrator. There are already several different funding sources available and they each have their own criteria for projects. We will do our best to get a simple matrix of these to you in the next few days. During the task force meeting the scale of devastation was so massive that it was difficult to take it all in.

Meanwhile back in the District the very successful Bob Dowden dinner raised just over \$12,000 and included a very emotional talk by Lion Judge Wayne Mack who recounted the effect on his family of his son going to the Camp. It was truly inspiring and was followed by other stories from campers and their parents who confirmed the life-altering effects of a week at the camp. We can be very proud of this humanitarian asset and I encourage you to donate – perhaps by awarding a Jack Wiech Fellowship to someone deserving in your club or community. The completed application form(s), will be provided to the Chairman of the District Governor's Honorary Committee. Said application may be made by any Lion in the District that is in good standing. The application(s) are required to be received by February 15th of each year and will be valid for that year only. If an applicant is not selected for that year, a new application must be submitted again to be considered for this award. There is no requirement to induct someone each and every year.

#### **MD-2 TEXAS LIONS HALL OF FAME**

- 1) Elevation of Lions into the Texas Lions Hall of Fame bestows an honor upon one who has been outstanding in using their time, talents and resources to further the cause of humanitarian services.
- 2) The MD-2 State Office shall, at the first council meeting each year, distribute information about nomination criteria to District Governors.
- 3) Selection shall be by the Hall of Fame Committee for each district. The committee of five members each, from different clubs, shall be appointed by the District Governor. The nominee shall be certified to the Council of Governors not later than the February Council meeting.
- 4) Minimum standards to qualify for the Texas Lions Hall of Fame are:
  - a) Be an active or deceased member with at least fifteen years of service,
  - b) Having provided outstanding and dedicated service to Lionism beyond the call of duty,
  - c) Having provided other than Lionistic service to community, state and nation,
  - d) Having accomplished special achievements in, or contributions to, humanitarian service for those less fortunate, and
  - e) Not having solicited in any manner for this recognition, which will automatically eliminate the soliciting candidate for that year.
- 5) A fee of \$227.50 shall accompany the nominee's profile. Selection of International Directors is automatic and no fee is required. The Hall of Fame fee covers the cost of the Hall of Fame Medallion and, the Hall of Fame Plaque, which is presented to each nominee.
- 6) Presentation of the selected nominee, by the District Governor, shall be at the MD-2 Convention. Each selected nominee will receive a duplicate of the plaque placed in the Hall of Fame.
- 7) A plaque with the names of to the Texas Lions Hall of Fame members shall be maintained in an appropriate space at the MD-2 State Office.
- 8) The nominees shall be selected in accordance with the following schedule:

#### THE PROBLEM

Measles is one of the most contagious yet easily prevented diseases in the world. It is still very much a deadly threat to people in areas that lack access to vaccinations. In fact, measles is a leading cause of vaccine-preventable deaths among children. The World Health Organization (WHO) estimates 122,000 deaths a year still occur due to measles.

For less than US\$1, a child can be immunized against measles for life, making the vaccine potentially the most cost-effective health intervention available. Ending measles can be a reality, but your help is needed. Lions have engaged in a long-term partnership with the GAVI Alliance, committing US\$30 million towards the fight against measles by our 100th anniversary in 2017.

#### THERE IS HOPE

In 2000, before the Measles Initiative was formed, more than 562,000 children died each year due to measles complications. Fortunately, between 2000 and 2012 increased access to vaccinations reduced measles deaths by 78 percent worldwide. In 2012, about 84 percent of children worldwide received a vaccination by their second birthday. But 335 children still die each day from measles.

Today, Lions, LCIF and our partners are hard at work, reaching those children who have not yet been vaccinated. Since becoming involved in the fight against measles in 2010, Lions and our partners have helped to vaccinate more than 200 million children. Through our newest partnership with the GAVI Alliance, millions more children will receive the vaccination.


